

Applying for School Card Grant - 2017

Dear Parents/Caregivers

The 2017 School Card Grant is a means-tested scheme to provide assistance of \$305.00 per student towards the cost of Materials & Services Charges for full time students of low income families.

The School Card Grant must be applied for each year.

Attached you will find the two most common application forms.

ED003A	<p>➤ All applicants who are liable for their child's Materials and Services Charges and who are not self-employed. <i>Note: This includes applicants where a student is over the age of 16 years.</i></p>	A separate form to each school
ED003B	<p>➤ Where the applicant(s) is self-employed.</p> <p>➤ Where the applicant(s) is over the School Card limits but have experienced hardship in the 2015/2016 financial year.</p> <p>➤ Where the applicant(s) has had a change of financial circumstances during the 2015/2016 financial year or up to and including the 28th February 2017.</p>	School Card Section (with supporting financial documentation)
