

ACTIVITIES WEEK INFORMATION 2017

Dear Parents, Caregivers & Students,

A leisure and recreation program will be conducted during the last week of Term 4 (Week 9) for all students. All students are expected to participate in this program unless there is a legitimate reason for exemption. An accompanying letter will be provided to students and collected by Home Group teachers to confirm participation.

Activities will run over 4 days: Monday 11th December to Thursday 14th December. On Friday 15th December the whole student population will visit the Regal Theatre in the morning to view a current release movie, at no cost. Students will be dismissed at 12:30pm after the distribution of Reports back at school.

On Monday to Thursday the day will be divided into 3 Sessions, with a break between each for Recess and Lunch as follows:

A wide range of activities will be available for student involvement. Individual activities will run over either one or two sessions (1.5 hours or 3 hours) depending upon their nature. In the case of extreme weather some activities may be cancelled and students may remain at the school. Students will have the opportunity to nominate their preferred activity for each session at a year level assembly. This will occur on **Friday 24/11/17, Year 9/10's from 11:30am-12:10pm and Year 8's from 12:15pm-1:00pm**. A second assembly for consent form collection will occur on Tuesday 28/11/17 during lesson 4 & 5.

While some activities are free, a large number involve a cost (listed on the following pages). Costs cover the activity for all four days and includes transport and materials. All costs will be further outlined on the consent form that students will receive from the teacher in charge. Payments will be required prior to the commencement of activities week.

Please read the activity information carefully. Before making your choices:

- consider the total cost of selected activities and
- any special requirements (dismissal location, personal equipment required, physical requirements).

There is a maximum number of students for each activity hence students should identify a number of preferred activities for each session prior to enrolment day. Opportunity will be provided for students to discuss choices (and record on the following page) during Home Group prior to the enrolment assembly. Measures will be in place to ensure that all students have the opportunity to select at least one first preference.
