

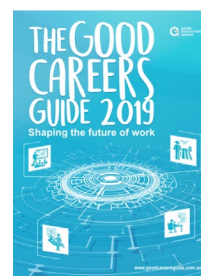

Students can access all course counselling materials at school from Daymap / Course Hub / Careers / Course Counselling

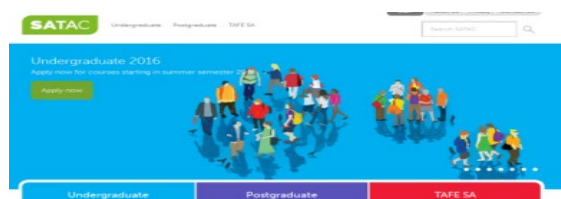

Final closing date for the following courses offered in 2021, late applications not accepted: Creative Arts (Drama) at Flinders University; Medicine/Surgery (including Bonded Medical place), Dental Surgery, Oral Health, and Veterinary Bioscience at the University of Adelaide. 18th December is change of preference deadline for semester 1 2021 courses.

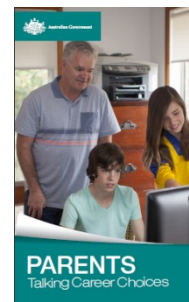
